CCWS: Instructions For Treatment



First course 5 days - 1 CCWS tablet 4 times a day with food containing some fat content. Then wait 10 days.

Second course 5 days – 1 CCWS tablet 4 times a day. Then wait 10 days.

Third course 5 days – 1 CCWS tablet 4 times a day. Then wait 10 days

This Is A Total 45 Day Treatment

All you need to do is **take 1 CCWS tablet with every meal four times a day** on the scheduled days.

Take the tablet when you are half way through your meal.

Make sure you do not have an upset stomach e.g. Diarrhea, so CCWS will be absorbed in your system.

Fat is needed to aid the absorption of CCWS, we recommend the following: Ghee, natural oils such as flax, olive, pumpkin etc. coconut oil is NOT advised as it works as a laxative and moves too fast through the digestive tract to allow treatment to be absorbed correctly. Animal fats work fine as well. A dish cooked with lots of oils is a very good way of making sure CCWS is taken into the fat tissue. We recommend 14 grams of fat per capsule. 1 full tablespoon of olive oil for example equals 14 grams of fat.

Your body needs a treatment that covers you for several weeks to allow your immune system to fluctuate. This is why we **STRONGLY** recommend the 5 days on 10 days off x 3 protocol which totals approximately 45 grams spread over 45 days.

Managing Candida Die-Off

When Candida Albicans yeast cell are killed 79 different toxic substances are released, including acetaldehyde and ethanol. These can cause symptoms ranging from headaches to fever.

Zeoco does not need to be taken on a schedule. People have different levels of die-off and at different stages of the cleanse so there is no set time. Our advice is to take the zeoco capsule

when die-off symptoms are particularly bad. You can take the Zeoco at any time during the 10 days break if you start feeling poorly from the build up of toxins released by the dying fungus. If you need to take a zeoco during the 5 day 'loading' phase then make sure you leave at least 2 hours between taking ccws and zeoco, this is to stop the zeoco absorbing the ccws treatment.

Frequently Asked Questions

What are the ingredients of CCWS ?

CCWS Candida Cleanser is a Chitin Synthesis Inhibitor, a iso9000 laboratory created inert chemical compound that acts solely on chitin based organisms such as Candida fungus. It is not broken down by the human body into any other chemical form and it does not cause any reaction in human body systems.

The principal active ingredient of CCWS is a propriety blend of pharmaceutical grade Lufenuron a completely non toxic fungicide that is pharmaceutical graded.

How Do I Know If I Have Candida?

Everyone has Candida yeast in their gut; it is natural and should be there. The problem arises when the Candida yeast in the gut manages to invade the bloodstream and develop into

another form which is Candida fungus. Due to Candida being ever present in our bodies in the yeast form it makes it more difficult to test as the test must be able to differentiate between fungus and yeast. This results in only blood testing as a reasonably reliable testing method. With our treatment you can effectively cleanse your body of Candida fungus.

How Does CCWS Kill Candida?

CCWS does not kill the fungus, what it does make the fungus vulnerable to attack by your immune system. It is after the treatment that your own white blood cells will finally be able to lay siege to the fungal colony. CCWS removes the fungus ability to generate the chitin layer which makes the fungus so difficult to attack.

Frequently Asked Questions

When will it work and i will start to feel the benefits?

Some people start the program and feel better almost immediately or within a few days, noticing positive effects such as increased energy, better mental focus, better elimination, etc. for these folks, the die-off experience is still likely to occur, but probably a few weeks down the road.

Do I Need A Doctors Prescription?

Is It Suitable For Children?

NO -As a child's immune system is still developing we would not recommend this treatment for anyone under 18 years of age.

Is It Suitable If I Am Pregnant?

We would not recommend this treatment for pregnant women or women who are breast feeding.

Will CCWS affect any other medications I am taking?

As lufenuron is an inert compound CCWS will not react with other medications. It is not advised to take antibiotics prior to or during the CCWS candida treatment. CCWS does not affect probiotic supplements or probiotic bacteria in the gut. CCWS is not eliminated by liver or kidneys but by the feces. CCWS has a glycemic index of zero and is safe for diabetic patients.

What Are The Side Effects?

The treatment has no side effects – however a die off reaction can occur which is often confused with being a side effect. The compound is inert and so to have a side effect it would have to be causing some kind of reaction in your body which it cannot.

Do I Need To Take It With Fat Rich Content Food?

By taking the treatment with fat rich food you ensure the uptake of the compound into the fat cells. This means that during the ten days rest from the course of tablets your fat cells will slowly release the treatment into your bloodstream. This means that there is a constant maintained level in your body.

Can My Candida Be Resistant To Chitin Synthesis Inhibitor?

Should resistance ever develop it would mean that the fungus is not using chitin anymore in its cell walls, and would therefore be more vulnerable to the immune system anyway. So far there is no record of a strain of Candida that does not use chitin based defenses.

Do I Need Antifungals Also?

You do not have to take antifungals with the treatment. Many people however do suffer with a strong die off reaction which can involve yeast infections flaring up. If this happens then a standard azole treatment will help relieve the situation.
